MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

NORTHERN LIGHTS is OPEN to all CNBTA and NON CNBTA Members. CANADIAN TITLE events are only eligible to CNBTA membership athletes who have met the participation requirements.

All Canadian athletes must be a current CNBTA member to participate in Title events and hae met season requirements. Please contact our CNBTA Technical Director. Please note that U.S.A participants will pay in Canadian funds and do not need to be a member of the CNBTA organization. Please keep in mind that CNBTA insurance coverage will NOT be applicable to U.S.A contestants.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Online entry is due **SATURDAY MAY 25, 2024**

U.S. ENTRIES – Please note that U.S. participants will pay in Canadian funds and do not need to be a member of the CNBTA organization. Please keep in mind that the CNBTA insurance coverage will **NOT** be applicable to U.S. contestants. This contest is only 2.5 hour from the Buffalo border

<u>VERIFICATION</u>: Coaches will receive a copy of their athletes'/club entries and will have a deadline for corrections or errors. Corrections made after the deadline may not be accommodated. *ANY STATUS CHANGES MUST BE REPORTED TO CNBTA TECHNICAL CHAIR NO LATER THAN MAY 31, 2024*

<u>Set System:</u> A Set System will be used for all events. A Program will be available for purchase with online entry. Copies will be posted around the facility. Coaches will be sent a draft system for any errors or omissions.

<u>Music:</u> All individual events use the Standard WFNBTA Music. All Rhythmic and Team music is to be submitted to the CNBTA Dropbox link that will be sent to all coaches. Music must be uploaded to Dropbox no later than April 8, 2024

Accommodations: Accessibility accommodations for athletes must be communicated to the Technical Director a minimum of 48 hours prior to the competition to ensure accommodations can be met

RUBY & DIAMOND CUP

Please note event requirements for the Cup event, an event introduced in the 2022 season. Results in the cup event will count towards regular advancement.

INTERMEDIATE-RUBY	Solo, 2 Baton, Rhythmic
ADVANCE-DIAMOND	Solo, Multi Baton (2 or 3 or combination of 2 & 3), Rhythmic

MISS MAJORETTE OF CANADA PAGEANT

The pageant will follow the NBTA rules and regulations regarding combined events including dress regulations for each level of the pageant. If you are not familiar with these rules, please contact the Technical Director at CNBTA. Technical director@gmail.com or refer to the CNBTA Rule Manual on our website: www.cnbta.net.

**Please note that NBTA USA rules now state you must be a US Citizen to be eligible to compete in Miss Majorette of America, however Beginner & Intermediate athletes are eligible to compete in the Beg & Int. Open Pageant event. All Canadians athletes are eligible to compete in world Open events, World Open Team events.

JUDGING

Judges' decisions are final. Tabulated results are final 48 hours after the completion of the competition day. Any issues regarding the results of the contest need to be raised prior to results being final using the "Result Conflict Form" found on the website or at the contest. Any other concerns regarding the contest are to be brought to the attention of the Technical Director.

AWARDS

A flexible system of awards will be used for all Cup and individual events based on number of entries. For Canadian Titles all classes less than 10 are awarded to 5th place, any division over 15 will be awarded to 10th. All pageant divisions are awarded to 5th place. Open events will be awarded to 3rd place, any division over 10 will be awarded to 5th.
